5 Flute and Piccolo

BOEHM: he invented the modern flute key system
 SILVER: professional flutes are made of this
 LIP PLATE: the player rests his or her lower lip here
 PICCOLO: a small flute
 FOOT JOINT: a short section with a few holes and keys
 NICKEL-PLATED: less expensive flutes are made this way
 GRENADILLA: a black wood that some piccolos are made of
 PITCH: the highness or lowness of a sound
 WOODWIND: the flute is a member of this instrument family
 BODY: the longest section of the flute
 EMBOUCHURE HOLE: air is blown across this to make a sound
