

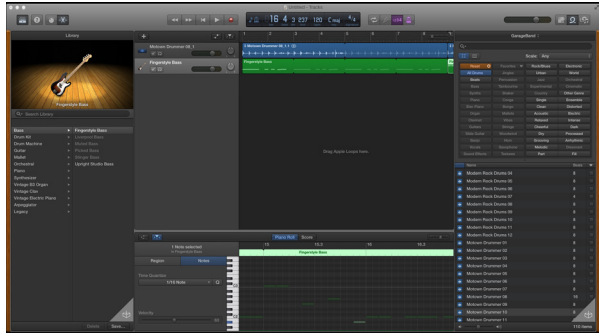
Garageband Projects for Mac

Student Assignment #1

Aim: To be able to choose and import loops from the Garageband loops library and make them into a short piece of music.

Task A

Drag in some drum loops and bass loops which work together and construct an 8 bar piece.

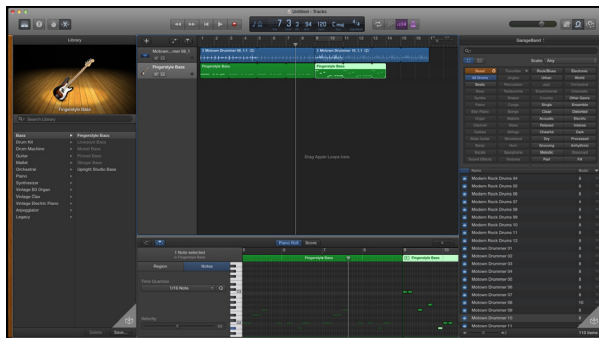


- Open the apple loops library.
- You can use Audio or MIDI Loops.
- Use whatever loops you like.
- Use the buttons at the top of the loop library to help you browse through them.

Task B:

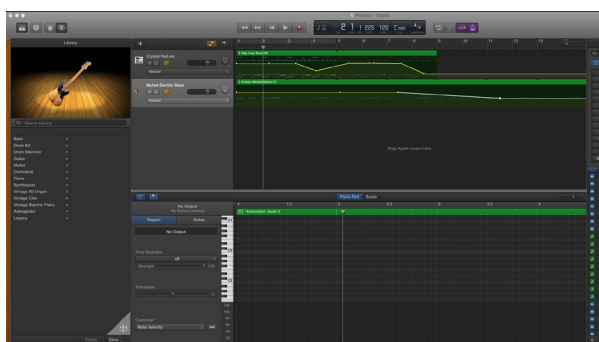
Create a contrasting section of your song to make it last 16 bars.



- Choose a contrasting, yet similar drum part to start with for the second 8 bars.
- Don't put in too much - keep it simple.
- Try not to change style too abruptly.

Task C:

Use Volume graphs to control the volume level of your drums and bass parts



- Find the button to switch on or off the volume graphs.
- Hold down the control key and click on the line to add a control point, and drag it up or down to control the volume.

Bonus Question:

Explain in your own words what the difference is between an AUDIO loop and a MIDI loop.
