

Funky Junky

Notes:

This piece requires each instrument to have two sounds - a 'side' and an 'end' (like a bass drum and snare drum sound)

Split them into four groups. Depending on how good their timing is, bars 9-16 can either be played by only those groups, as a 'build up' or everyone in unison. You can even do it differently on the repeat if you wish.

(Track) Unison Play

7 (group 1) (group 2)
side end side side end etc....

13 (group 3) (group 4)

19 Unison (hit sticks together)

25 Repeat from bar 7

31 (Track) Unison Play
